# Communication Program 2024-2027 Course Rotation

#### **Dear UTPB Communication Students:**

Everybody in the COMM Department is committed to your success. As part of that commitment, we want you to be able to plan for when courses will be offered. Since 2019, we have published a regular rotation of when we plan to offer our courses—both online and face to face. Sometimes emergencies come up which cause us to change things, and quite often we are able to offer additional classes beyond what is listed here. However, this is an excellent planning guide for when things should be available in each format. Here are several general things you need to know:

- Our program is offered both face to face and online.
- You are free to take courses in either format (online or face to face) which is convenient to you. However, if you are physically in the Petroplex (Odessa/Midland), we strongly encourage you to take our classes face to face in the Fall and Spring semesters.
- Our Summer classes are almost entirely online, although we are happy to offer something face to face if we know there is demand for it.
- The senior capstone course, COMM 4390, will be offered online every Fall and in person every Spring.
- COMM 1301 and 1315 will be offered every semester.
- COMM 1115 is only offered online, and only during long semesters.
- Core courses for which there is more than one alternative (COMM 1318/2333) are offered alternately.

In Spring 2022 we began offering students specialized tracks in Strategic Messaging, Professional Communication, Sports Media, and Communication Studies. The full description of those tracks is later in this document, and we hope you will visit with your adviser and faculty members about how each of these options will visit your goals.

The following pages tell you what we plan to offer each semester. We will always add additional options when staffing permits, but if you see a class you know you will need please use this guide to plan for when to take it. Please work closely with your adviser, and send me an email or stop by my office (MB 4156) to let me know how I can help.
