GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS:

1. Read the UTPB catalog and be familiar with all requirements for the BSN degree. It is the student's responsibility to know/fulfill all requirements.
2. At least 48 sch must be taken at the upper level.
3. At least 30 of those hours must be completed at UTPB.
4. An overall GPA of 2.5 or higher for all classes taken at UTPB.
5. A GPA of 2.5 or higher in all classes counting for the degree.
6. A minimum grade of "C" in all courses counting towards the BSN, including general education core, nursing core, and electives. **All courses must be completed with a grade of C or better. Exceptions are Biology I/Lab, Biology II/Lab, Microbiology/Lab, Anatomy/Lab, & Physiology/Lab require a grade of "B" or higher.**
7. Students who enrolled in a Texas public institution of higher education as first-time freshman in the Fall 2007 and thereafter are **not permitted to drop more than six courses** during their entire undergraduate career (Texas Administrative Code 4.10). This limit includes all transfer work taken at a Texas institution of higher

MAJOR REQUIREMENTS:

The BSN degree requires a minimum of **120 sch**, (121 if Math 4 sch) with at least **48** upper level credits (3000/4000) and **DOES NOT REQUIRE A MINOR**. The program consists of: (1) Pre-Nursing major; and (2) the Nursing major.
