

Completer Employment in Appropriate Positions (Initial and Advanced) 2020-2021 Academic Year

Initial Programs

Of the candidates who completed initial certification in 2019-2020, and who responded concerning their employment status for 2020-2021, 92% were reported by the state as being employed within a year. For those who were fully certified five years previously, 63% were remaining in the profession as teachers, per state report (next page). However, many of those exiting the profession as teachers were continuing as educators in other roles such as counselors, principals and educational diagnosticians.

Advanced Programs

Of the candidates who completed advanced certification in 2019-2020, and who responded concerning their employment status for 2020-2021, 100% of those prepared as educational diagnosticians and school counselors were hired for position in which they had been prepared. On the other hand, the rate was less than 20% for those prepared as principals and reading specialists, where it is common for candidates to continue as a classroom teacher for a year or more after completing their program.
