

PROOF OF SELECTIVE SERVICE TASFA APPLICATION

STUDENT COMPLIANCE WITH SELECTIVE SERVICE

A male student cannot receive a grant, scholarship, loan or other financial assistance funded by state revenue, unless a statement of the individual's selective service status is completed with the institution or other entity granting or guaranteeing the financial assistance.

For a student that does not complete FAFSA, the required statement and back up documentation must be collected.

A. If registered, student must provide the following:

A copy of your registration acknowledgement card **or** Online Memorandum for registrant

* Visit www.sss.gov/Home/Verification for online memorandum

B. If not register (under the age of 18), student must provide proof of date of birth:

Example: Birth certificate **or** state issued driver's license/ID

* If you are under the age of 18 you must submit a proof of selective service exemption/waiver form each academic year until you are registered.

C. If exempt from selective service, student must provide the following:

Military=DD-214 **Incarcerated/hospitalized**=Provide proof of confinement (type/dates) **Noncitizen alien**= copy of F1 I-20
Certificate of Eligibility for Nonimmigrant Student Status

Required Statement of Selective Service Status

Are you currently registered for Selective, as required by the federal law?

A. Registered

(Proof of registration required)

B. Not Registered

(Under the age of 18, proof of DOB required)

C. Exempt

(Supporting documentation required)
