Director's Award Choral Scholarship

Incoming UTPB students interested in participating in choral ensembles may apply for the Director's Award, a \$500 scholarship (split between Fall and Spring semesters) based on the recommendation of their choir director, as well as their musical and academic achievements. This scholarship is open to any incoming student, regardless of intended major.

Four awards per academic year are available.

Directors are allowed to recommend two students per school per year.

Application materials are as follows:

• Student Materials

- Essay: In approximately 500 words, describe how you plan to incorporate choral music into your collegiate career and how you believe singing in an ensemble will benefit you during your time at UTPB.
- o **Resume**: Detailing musical experience, academic achievements, and any other information the applicant would like to share (EX: work experience, theatre productions, other clubs and organizations, etc.) Two page maximum, please.
- o **Unofficial Transcripts**: Must include all grades from freshman to senior year of high school. Electronic submission only.

• Choral Director Materials

- o Letter of Recommendation: One page only, please.
- Records (optional): Any records of student's participation in UIL and TMEA sponsored events (judging sheets, programs, etc.), as well as any other musical honors received while in your ensemble
