#### **ABOUT HOMECOMING**

#### THEME SELECTION

The theme for this year's homecoming was decided on by the Homecoming Committee! The theme will be <u>"Falcon Flashback: Decades Edition</u> for the Fall 2025 Homecoming season.

The events throughout the week will fit the theme. Teams that will be competing in this year's homecoming spirit competitions should plan to incorporate the theme into their team's name and in the competitions, they compete in.

#### **SPIRIT COMPETITION**

Any combination of students, faculty, and staff are welcome to compete in the spirit competition. Competing teams MUST have at least 5 members and a maximum of 10. While student organizations may sign up as an organization, students not involved in any organizations may also sign up to participate.

Teams will compete in various activities throughout the week, as explained in this packet. Teams can choose to attend any or all events, but those who attend all have the greatest chance of receiving the most points by the end of the week.

The winning team will be announced at the football game on <u>Saturday</u>, <u>October 25<sup>th</sup></u>. The winners will have their name etched in history on a Homecoming Spirit Competition Trophy held in the Center for Student Involvement (SAC 200).

To participate, teams must sign up using the <u>Microsoft form link</u> provided by the Office of Student Life. Registration closes on Sunday, October 12<sup>th</sup> at 10pm.

## STUDENT ORGANIZATION/CLUBS BANNER COMPETITION

Event Information: Sunday, October 19th from 12:00pm - 5:00pm

Check-in: 11:30am | UTPB GYM (Upstairs)

#### **Banner Competition Rules:**

- 1. The sign must not exceed 12x15 feet and must be at least 9 x12 feet (not including the poles). Signs that do not meet these dimensions will be disqualified.
- 2. Should your team win the contest, you are responsible for the poles used to hold the signs at the football game.
- 3. The materials will be provided by the Office of Student Activities.
- 4. All teams must take their banner to the SAC and hang it up. Any remaining signs at the gym will receive a 10-point deduction from their overall homecoming points.

#### Judging Rubric:

- Use of Theme (1 10pts)
- Creativity (1 10pts)
- UTPB Spirit (1 − 10pts)
- Originality (1 10pts)

Winner will be announced on Tuesday, October 21st during Nailed It.

#### **Winners:**

The 1<sup>st</sup> place sign will be used at the start of the Homecoming football game. They will be required to meet at the game with their signs, poles and people holding the sign no later than 5:15pm.

The 2<sup>nd</sup> place sign should be on standby in case of an emergency on the day of the game.

Groups are responsible for their poles to hold the sign at the football game and to have members available to clean the field right after the run through.

#### HOMECOMING ROYALTY COMPETITION

Event Information: Monday, October 20<sup>th</sup>, 6PM

**Location:** Library Event Center

Check-in: 5:30PM

#### **Homecoming Royalty Nominations and Elections:**

- Only one (1) king and one (1) queen nominee per organization/department.
- The nominating organization/department must be participating in homecoming.
- Nominees must have <u>at least</u> a 2.0 cumulative GPA.
- Nominees must be a junior, senior, or graduate student to be eligible.
- Nominees must be in good disciplinary standing with UT Permian Basin.
- Each group/department is responsible for ensuring their candidates are eligible under the guidelines established by the UT Permian Basin Homecoming Committee.

To ensure candidate eligibility before the deadline, submit nominee forms soon as possible to provide enough time to review and resubmit a nomination if necessary.

#### **Nomination Form:**

- Court nominees must accept the nomination before submitting the Court Nomination Form
- It is the nominators responsibility to fill out the Court Nomination Form.
  - (YOU CANNOT NOMINATE YOURSELF).
- Nominators must fill out the Court Nomination Form via the Microsoft Form link provided by the office of Student Activities. This form can be found on the homecoming website.
   This form is due by October 10<sup>th</sup>.
- The nomination form includes a brief statement (300 words or less) about who you are and why you are running for Homecoming King/Queen. If you are selected for the ballot, your statement may be included on the form.

#### Requirements:

Nominees may not campaign until they are confirmed to be on the Homecoming ballot
and have attended a campaign meeting with the Homecoming committee or received and
email. If you want to post flyers around campus, please have them approved by Selene
Corcino, Assistant Director of Student Activities, corcino s@utpb.edu, by October 13th
to have them up in time.

• If the nominee advances to Homecoming Court, they must be present at the Homecoming Court Presentation on October 20<sup>th</sup> at 6pm. **Please arrive by 5:30pm.** 

#### Finalists MUST be present at the following events:

- Homecoming parade on October 24<sup>th</sup> at 7 p.m. <u>Homecoming Royalty please arrive by</u> 6:30pm.
- Homecoming Royalty Presentation, <u>Saturday, October 25<sup>th</sup></u> during football game halftime.
- Halftime field practice at the UTPB (University of Texas Permian Basin) soccer field at a time that is to be determined.
- Homecoming football game Saturday, October 25<sup>th</sup> at Astound Broadband Stadium (Midland).

#### Voting:

- For this competition there will be two rounds of voting. Preliminary voting to determine the homecoming court will be held on October 13<sup>th</sup> October 17<sup>th</sup>. Homecoming court will be announced at the Homecoming Court Presentation on Monday, October 20<sup>th</sup> at 6pm.
- Final voting for Homecoming King and Queen will take place Monday, October 20<sup>th</sup> Friday, October 24<sup>th</sup> with form closing at 10am.

For <u>preliminary voting stage</u>, students can vote for up to 4 kings and queens, and in the <u>final</u> voting stage, students can only vote for 1 king and queen.

The Fashion Show is a competition of several rounds, each meant to showcase a specific decade. The five decades that will make up the five rounds are the 60s, 70s, 80s, 90s, 2000s. The rounds will follow that order.

#### **Fashion Show Rules:**

- 1.) The competition will consist of 5 rounds consisting of 5 players each.
- 2.) For each round, each team will have one representative of their group following the theme of the decade of that round.
- **3.)** No inappropriate costumes. This includes profanity, nudity, gang affiliation or cultural appropriation. Cultural appropriation is defined as the act of taking or using things from a culture that is not your own, especially without showing that you understand or respect this culture. Any fault with these criteria will result in automatic disqualification.

#### LIP SYNC/KARAOKE BATTLE

Event Information: Wednesday, October 22<sup>nd</sup> at 7:00pm in the SAC

Each team will be allowed a maximum of five minutes to perform, including introductions and exits. If the performance is starting on stage and the entrance is not included in the choreography, time will start at the first movement. Teams are responsible for coming up with their costumes, choreography, and song choice.

#### **Lip Sync Rules:**

- 1. Each team has a maximum of 5 minutes to perform their songs/compilations.
- 2. Teams must submit their songs and a list of performing members (max of 10) to corcino s@utpb.edu no later than October 14th by 5:00 p.m.
- 3. All songs must be clean versions no exceptions.
- 4. Songs should align with but are not limited to the homecoming theme. Teams can earn more points for use of the Homecoming theme.
- 5. No inappropriate costumes. This includes profanity, nudity, gang affiliation or cultural appropriation. Cultural appropriation is defined as the act of taking or using things from a culture that is not your own, especially without showing that you understand or respect this culture. Any fault with these criteria will result in automatic disqualification
- 6. Choreography must be appropriate. No vulgar dance moves. Any fault of this will also result in automatic disqualification.
- 7. No contact between performers and judges or audience members is allowed.
- 8. No glitter, confetti, or difficult to clean props may be used.
- 9. Teams must attend a sound check on a specified date.
- 10. The order of performances will be drawn at random during check-in.

### **Dodgeball Tournament**

#### **Dodgeball Rules:**

1. A minimum of six team members must participate.

- 2. Everyone must sign the Release and Indemnification Agreement Form.
- 3. All members must be current UTPB students with a valid student ID.
- 4. Players must be behind the back line until balls are released.

#### **Eliminations:** A player is out if:

- 1. They are hit by a ball (before it touches the floor/ceiling/wall).
- 2. Their throw ball is caught by the other team.
- 3. They step out of bounds or cross the center line.

#### **Boundaries:**

- 1. Players must remain inside court lines.
- 2. No stepping over the center line to throw.

#### **Throws & Deflections:**

- 1. Players may use a ball to block, but if the ball is knocked out of their hands, they're out.
- 2. Headshots do not count unless the player ducked into the throw.

#### **Sportsmanship:**

- 1. A 10-second penalty will be added for unsportsmanlike behavior.
- 2. Teams can earn extra points by creating a team chant.
- 3. Referees have the final say on all calls.

- **3.** Teams must drive 1-5 mph on their route.
- 4. Students may not hang out of their vehicle side windows.
- 5. Teams may only toss store-bought pre-packaged candy.

If a student organization/club needs to decorate their float, they will meet in the parking lot next to the Founders Building at 10:00 AM on Friday, October 24. The parking lot will be blocked off by UTPB Police.

Parade participants will meet the HOCO Committee members there at 6:00 PM to check in. (Floats must be ready for parade)
